LISTER STREET U9/U10 FIELD TAKEDOWN PROCEDURE.

All the fields at the Lister Street precinct must be taken down & tidied each week that games are scheduled there. The Club does this using volunteers (parents/caregivers of participating Sunnybank teams) from each of the teams within the Club.

VOLUNTEERS SHOULD BEGIN TO CLEAR THE FIELD IMMEDIATELY THE FINAL GAME FOR EACH FIELD (USUALLY @ 10:10 or 11:20AM) FINISHES AND BEFORE THE AWARDS & TEAM DEBRIEF IS STARTED.

THIS IS TO ENSURE THE GAMES IMMEDIATELY AFTER CAN BEGIN ON TIME.

ALSO NOTE - IF GAMES ARE BEING PLAYED ON EITHER SMALL FIELD OR THE FULL FIELD, THEN ALL PLAYERS AND VOLUNTEERS SHOULD REMAIN OUTSIDE THE FIELD FENCES ON BOTH SIDES OF THE FIELD WHEN RETURNING EQUIPMENT TO THE STORAGE AREA.

The work is relatively easy (does not include a lot of heavy lifting) is done under the supervision of the precinct Line Marking Co-ordinator.

The list of general duties is as follows:

- Takedown of goal frames & nets. END TRIANGULAR PIECES SHOULD NOT BE TAKEN APART, simply tied together using coloured stretchy toggles provided. The top and bottom crossbars should be pulled apart, nets folded, U pegs collected and all these placed in the black bags provided.
- Collect the corner flags.
- Collect substitute benches – take four to area immediately in front of the small stands (2no. /stand) on the Lister St. side of the field.
- General sweep of field for litter and other objects left behind.
- All goal bags, triangular goal frame ends, corner flags and remaining substitute benches should then be returned to the last roller door (next to the caged area) for storage

This weekend there are two fields (both small size) and four goals to be taken down.

We need at least three (more would be great) volunteers from each team to ensure the field is cleared quickly.

The more people who help from your team the quicker and easier the takedown will be.

The last game for either fields are usually scheduled to begin at 10:10 or 11:20AM.

If you could organise your team members to help, please have them begin to clear the field and dismantle the goals IMMEDIATELY after the last game finishes.

This will ensure the games following commence at the scheduled kick off time and the Club avoids a QCSA fine
