YANDINA PARK TAKE DOWN UP

The field to be used at the Brittain Park precinct must be tided and packed up each week that games are scheduled there. The Club does this using volunteers from the Sunnybank Saints team playing last there. **These volunteers should begin the pack up A.S.A practical after the game finishes.**

The last SSFC team are requested to do the field pack up at the Yandina Park precinct on any Saturday that the QCSA fixtures schedule dictates.

ALWAYS CHECK WITH ST.PAULS FIELDS COORDINATOR (IAIN WILLIAMSON) BEFORE STARTING TAKEDOWN TO ENSURE YOU ARE THE LAST GAME ON THAT FIELD.

The work is relatively easy (does not include a lot of heavy lifting)

The list of general duties is as follows:

- 1.Take down of goal nets & net pegs (18no total. ie 9no./net) place in provided bucket and then place into wheelie bin and return to storage area.
- 2.Collect corner flags(4no.) and return to storage area
- 3.Collect sub benches (4no. chairs/subs.area) and return to storage area.
- 4.General sweep of fields for litter and other objects, place in small black rubbish bins provided and empty rubbish bins into appropriate large skip bin.

WHEELIE BINS MUST NOT BE USED FOR RUBBISH, THEY ARE FOR EQUIPMENT ONLY.

Most weekends there is only one field (full size) and two goals to be taken down.

We need at least four (more would be great) volunteers from your team to ensure the field is taken down successfully. The more people who help from your team the quicker and easier the take down is completed..

Field should be cleared within 30 - 40 mins. of your game finishing. if possible.

If you could organise your team members, parents and supporters to help it would be most appreciated by the Club
