Yandina Park precinct on any Saturday that the QCSA fixtures schedule dictates.

The work is relatively easy (does not include a lot of heavy lifting) and is done under the supervision of the St. Paul's Precinct Co-ordinator (contact number below).

The list of general duties are as follows:

- Set up of goal nets
 - Corner flags
 - Rubbish bins
- Set up of substitute benches
- General sweep of fields for litter and other objects

Most weekends there is only one field (full size) and two goals to be set-up.

We need at least four (more would be great) volunteers from your team to ensure the field is ready to play. The more people who come from your team the quicker and easier the setup is.

Field should be ready for referee's inspection approx.10 mins. before the scheduled kick off time for the first game scheduled there.

If you could organise your team members to help, please have them arrive at:

Yandina Park precinct no later than 60 mins. prior to the scheduled kick off of the first game.

Please be aware the precinct is normally very damp due to the overnight dew.

Waterproof footwear is highly recommended.
